Comments of Matthew Handelman Superintendent, School District 271 Excerpted From Superintendent's Report Board of Trustees Meeting March 3, 2014

Handelman: Thank you, Chair Hearn. Members of the Board.

I have a number of things to report to you tonight. Um. The first is something that Mr. Kohles [phonetic], ah, mentioned before – the Day on the Hill.
